- The Language -I of the Assam Teacher Eligibility Test (ATET) / BTC TET of the candidate shall 1. match the medium of the school, wherein the candidate wishes to apply. As for example, if a candidate wishes to apply in an Assamese Medium School, the candidate must have Assamese as Language-I in the Assam / BTC TET. Likewise, for Bodo as Bodo Language School, the candidate must have Bodo as Language-I in Assam / BTC TET conducted by Elementary Education Department, Assam.
- The Criteria-1 will come in force in case of Assistant Teacher for LP School and Assistant Teacher, 2. Science Teacher of UP School.
- The Criteria-1 will not come into force in respect of Assamese Language Teacher and Manipuri 3. Language Teacher of UP Schools.
- The Merit List will be separate for each district and category. 4.
