Applications are invited from the teachers of Bangalore University and its affiliated colleges to fill-up the post of full-time NSS Programme Co-ordinator in Bangalore University on deputation basis for a period of 3 (three) years from the date of appointment and extendable by 1 year at the discretion of the University.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- (a) Assistant / Associate Professor in the University or affiliated colleges.
- (b) Principal of affiliated college, of the status of Associate Professor with NSS back ground.
- (c) Must have been a NSS Programme Officer for at least three years.
- (d) Must have undergone NSS orientation in a TOC/TORC.
- (e) Not more than 50 years of age at the time of selection as Coordinator

The prescribed application (**format enclosed**) in **FIVE** sets along with relevant copies of the certificates should be submitted to the University on or before **18.10.2021** through the Department Chairman/Principal concerned.

The Chairpersons / Principals are requested to obtain filled-in applications from eligible teachers and forward them to the Registrar, Bangalore University, Jnana Bharathi, Bangalore-560 056. While forwarding the applications, the Chairman/Principals are requested to follow the guidelines of Government of India in this regard. Applications forwarded beyond the last date will not be entertained.

Selection will be made through the process of interview of eligible candidates as per NSS Manual 2006 (Revised). The candidates shall produce the original documents to prove their age, qualification, experience etc. at the time of interview failing which their candidature shall be cancelled, at the time of verification of documents itself. The date and the venue of the interview shall be intimated later.
