- 5. Applications in the prescribed format, downloaded from MCC website, will only be accepted.
- **6. Signed, hard copy of the application form** with self-attested copies of certificates (for proving age, qualification, experience, bed strength, Application Fee Remittance Receipt containing UTR number etc.) should be forwarded to The Director, Malabar Cancer Centre, Moozhikkara PO, Thalassery, Kerala-670103 on or before **28–10-2021.**
